# Individuals Entitled to McKinney-Vento Protection May Enroll Immediately Without Records

It is expected that many individuals recently displaced by hurricanes who come to NYS will be able to register their children in school without the documents normally required for enrollment, because their temporary housing arrangements will likely meet the definition of "homeless" in the federal McKinney-Vento Act. The definition of "homeless" in McKinney-Vento includes students who are temporarily staying with another family because they have lost their home due to a natural disaster. McKinney-Vento eligibility determinations are made on a case-by-case basis. For more information about McKinney-Vento, see <a href="https://www.nysteachs.org">www.nysteachs.org</a>.

However, if you currently have access to the following documents, please gather them before relocating to New York State – while they are not required if you are covered by the McKinney-Vento Act, having them may expedite your child's enrollment and placement into NYS schools. Please keep in mind that enrollment procedures and requirements vary by district, provided they follow certain minimum requirements.

## **Documents Needed For Enrollment In New York State By Permanently Housed Students**
