

COURSE: HOME FURNISHINGS

OVERVIEW OF COURSE

Goal

The goal of this course is to expand the student's knowledge of home furnishings through detailed exploration of the field.

Description

Home Furnishings is designed to teach students how to work with woods and textiles in the home. Each module will provide students with the techniques necessary to create a project in that category. It is a how-to course which includes an extensive hands-on project as part of the requirements. Skills developed will be related to careers.

Skills, Knowledge, and Behaviors to be Developed

The ability to:

1. Identify related careers.
2. Identify the wood types used in furniture.
3. Perform simple repairs on wood furniture.
4. Understand furniture refinishing techniques and applications.
5. Explain decorative and functional roles of textiles in home furnishings.
6. Demonstrate a specific skill by the completion of a project within the curriculum.
